MAKE A PAPER PLATE COW

Use our template to help you make a paper plate cow

RESOURCES

Large paper plate

White paper

2 google eyes

Brown felt

Crayons/pencils/felt tips

Scissors and glue

Our cow template



HOW TO MAKE

- 1. Print out template and cut the pieces out (adults should help younger children)
- 2. Place the semi-circle shape on the brown felt to cut out shape or colour this shape with brown crayon/pencil or felt tip.
- 3. Glue the brown semi circle to the bottom of the cows head. Use black crayon/pencil to draw on 2 nostrils and a smile
- 4. Use a pink crayon to colour the centre of the ears. Glue 2 google eyes on to the head
- 5. Draw hooves onto the bottoms of the legs using a black crayon/pencil. Glue the legs onto the "bottom" of the paper plate. You could glue two on the from and 2 on the back.
- 6. Glue the tail to the paper plate. Cut some small slits in the end of the tail.
- 7. Cut out some spots out of the brown felt and glue them on to the cow (if you do not have felt you could use brown paper or just colour in the spots.
